DIAGNOSING BLADDER CANCER

Chesapeake Urology's bladder cancer specialists are experienced in the most advanced diagnostic techniques that can identify bladder cancer quickly and accurately. In addition to a comprehensive medical exam, additional diagnostic testing may include:

- Urine cytology, Fluorescence in Situ Hybridization (FISH) and other tumor marker tests
- CT urography
- Cystoscopy

STAGING BLADDER CANCER

If bladder cancer is diagnosed, the urologist will determine the cancer "disease state" before recommending treatment. There are three main categories of bladder cancer:

- Non-muscle invasive bladder cancer
- Muscle-invasive or locally advanced bladder cancer
- Metastatic bladder cancer

TREATING BLADDER CANCER

A Chesapeake Urology bladder cancer specialist will develop a personalized and comprehensive treatment plan that best meets the individual needs of the patient and coordinate care with the patient's primary care physician. Surgical treatment is often recommended for patients with bladder cancer. Some patients will receive radiation, chemotherapy or immunotherapy in addition to, or instead of, surgery.

Surgical and other therapeutic approaches include:

- Transurethral resection (TUR)
- Radical cystectomy
- Radiation therapy
- Chemotherapy
- Immunotherapy

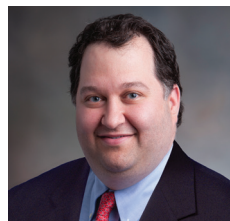
